We are looking to expand our pool of external Policy Consultants and look for a candidate who is:

- <u>A Master</u>: someone who masters lobbying and EU Affairs. Someone who understands the challenges of nonprofit advocacy, and more broadly civil society sector in Europe.
- <u>A Problem Solver</u>: you know how to monitor policies and you know how to craft strategies to make change happen.
- <u>A Facilitator</u>: someone who loves public speaking and seeks to be a bridge-builder between different environments (e.g. public, private, civil society sectors)

The challenges we will propose to you:

- Support the education and policy teams on a variety of projects, including The Good Lobby EU Masterclass, Fossil Fuel Finance Lab, and The Good Lobby Hub
- Deliver trainings and provide advice for organisations coming from different walks of life and sectors (civil society, private sector, grassroots, etc in lobbying and advocacy).

- Create contents in the context of The Good Lobby Hub, assist in identifying speakers, and participate as a speaker in the Hub's webinars.

What we are looking for in our Policy Consultant:

- 5-7 years experience in EU public affairs or advocacy, gained in a consultancy, law firm, EU institution and/or NGO.
- Strong command of EU policy-making processes.
- Outstanding public speaking skills and teaching experience would be an asset.
- Expertise in designing and implementing advocacy strategies.
- Experience working on energy, sustainability, and/or just transition would be an asset.
- Creativity, flexibility and openness to change.
- Understanding of the challenges of the nonprofit sector and European civil society.

This is a freelance position with flexible working hours, invoiced monthly based on project needs. We are open to candidates based outside of Brussels.
